IDEM Quarterly Report was discussed and approved for submittal.

Justin's Report: Incident report was presented. The installation of the E-Ticket Equipment in the truck has been completed by CopsGear. E-Ticket should be up and running within a few weeks once IT gives access. Aaron Yearigan covered the town while Justin was on vacation and everything went well. Jim mentioned that traffic does not stop early in the morning at 14 and 19.

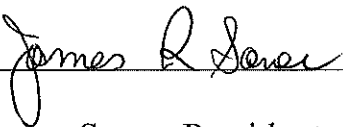

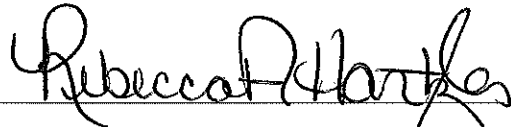
Andy discussed the easement to the lagoons after Channing Utter made contact with him over roadway damage. A meeting will be scheduled with all concerned when it is convenient.
