The Public Hearing for Ordinance 03-19-2019 authorizing additional appropriations opened at 5:00. Discussion was opened to the public. No comments. The Public Hearing closed at 5:02 p.m.

Regular meeting opened at 5:02. Brandon made a motion to approve the February 18, 2019 meeting minutes as written. Rich 2<sup>nd</sup>. 3 ayes.

Discussion was had for the AT&T backup generator contract. Wording was amended in the proposed contract.

Justin's Report: Incident report was presented. Commission goes to Copsgear the 1<sup>st</sup> of April for updating equipment for E-ticketing. Checked with AT&T for First-Net cell service for emergency responders. The Radar trailer will be operational toward the end of April. Jim spoke about the clean up on Walnut St and was appreciating the effort made. He also mentioned trash build-up at Cherry St. residence.

Aaron's Report: Aaron presented a quote from Bobcat and Case for a skid loader. Bobcat was the low bid for \$14,900. Jim made a motion to approve the quote from Bobcat. Brandon 2<sup>nd</sup>. 3 ayes. A quote from D&D and Banner Electric for lift

station upgrades was presented. Rich made a motion to accept the quote from Banner for \$2200. Brandon 2<sup>nd</sup>. 3 ayes. The new flow meter at the lagoons was installed and working well. The new mower was delivered. Reminder that leaves and grass are in containers for pick up.


Andy Perkins requested clarification on a request to amend an ordinance.


Rich made a motion to approve Dockets for \$257,902.21. Brandon 2<sup>nd</sup>. 3 ayes.
